Abstracts submission for the meeting

Abstract submission will be open on April 1, 2015.

Submission Deadline: June 15, 2015.

Important Note: We recommend that you submit your abstract through our website(<http://jsdh32.umin.jp/abstract.html>). Please follow the instructions on the website and make sure that you include your complete mail address information and contact information for the authors.

Abstract

All abstracts must be submitted online.

The online abstract submission system is available from the middle of May, 2015.

Please indicate your preference for the format of the presentation (Oral or Poster) as well as the theme, title, author(s), affiliations(s) and abstract text.

Please read the remarks below regarding the abstraction submission.

Annual Meeting Award: A prize will be awarded for the best abstract.

Or The best abstract will be awarded

Format of presentation: Oral or Poster

Maximum number of authors: 20 per abstract.

Author's affiliation: Enter the affiliation of all authors or only the first author.

Category: Please indicate the appropriate presentation category when submitting online.

Title: Maximum of 60 characters.

Abstract Text: The abstract must include the following elements:

objective(s), method(s), results, data and statistical analysis, conclusions and references.

Please note that the abstract is limited to approximately 2,500 characters, excluding the title, names of authors/co-authors, the authors' affiliations, spacing and layout.

In addition, tables and graphics (8cm x 5cm) will reduce 300-400 characters from the total limit allowed. Abstracts exceeding the character limit will be considered "incomplete. Abstracts marked "incomplete" at the close of the submission deadline will NOT be eligible for consideration.

Please be advised that you will need your abstract submission password and abstract submission number when changing and confirming the details of your presentation.
